



DRAIN FLY TREATMENT PREPARATION CHECKLIST & INFORMATION

People & pets are required to be out of the service area for the duration of the treatment, and for the 2 hours after the treatment was completed to allow the product to dry properly.

Interior Areas That Will Be Treated:

- Beneath all sinks, bathtubs and around all water fittings
- Inside all drains
- If the drain flies have migrated away from sinks/drains, the technician will spray around any windows in the affected area, and around any sliding doors.
- Along any additional problem areas discussed with the technician

Preparation for Treatment

Ensure you, and all pets have somewhere to go for 2-3 hours, as you will need to be out of the house for the duration of the treatment and for 2 hours afterward.

- Pick-up any clothes or toys that are on the floor
- Cover all fish tanks with a blanket or a towel

After the Treatment:

To ensure the drain flies do not return, it is important to clean their breeding ground (i.e., thoroughly clean the organic matter in the area where you are seeing drain flies).

Safety of Treatment

Technicians will use Dragnet (diluted to 0.05%) to spray the home, which is safe for both people, including children, and pets, with the exception of fish. For more information, download a Material Safety Data Sheet from our website [here](#).
