



PHORID FLY TREATMENT PREPARATION CHECKLIST & INFORMATION

People & pets are required to be out of the service area for the duration of the treatment, and for the 2 hours after the treatment was completed to allow the product to dry properly.

Interior Areas That Will Be Treated:

- Inside all drains
- Around any areas with organic matter that has attracted the flies
- Along any additional problem areas discussed with the technician

Preparation for Treatment

Ensure you, and all pets have somewhere to go for 2-3 hours, as you will need to be out of the house for the duration of the treatment and for 2 hours afterward.

- Clean the drains & remove as much of the organic material as possible
- Use a biological drain cleaner daily until the date of your treatment
- Cover all fish tanks with a blanket or a towel

After the Treatment:

To ensure the phorid flies do not return, it is important to clean their breeding ground (i.e., thoroughly clean the organic matter in the area where you are seeing phorid flies).

Safety of Treatment

Technicians will use Dragnet (diluted to 0.05%) to spray the home, which is safe for both people, including children, and pets, with the exception of fish. For more information, download a Material Safety Data Sheet from our website [here](#).
