



GENERAL BEETLE TREATMENT PREPARATION CHECKLIST & INFORMATION

People & pets are required to be out of the service area for the duration of the treatment and for the 2 hours after the treatment was completed to allow the product to dry properly.

Interior Areas That Will Be Treated:

- Around all baseboards
- Around the kitchen and or bathroom (countertops, cupboards, drawers, etc.)
- Inside of closets
- In any additional areas you are noticing the beetles

Preparation for Treatment:

Ensure you and all pets have somewhere to go for 3 hours, as you will need to be out of the house for the duration of the treatment and for 2 hours afterward.

- Clean out all closets – everything needs to come out
- If the beetles are in the kitchen: Empty, all drawers/cupboards with food and place all items on the table (do not place on countertops).
- If beetles are in the bathroom: Empty all cupboards/drawers, clear countertops
- Cover all fish tanks with a towel/blanket (ensure it is one that has gone through the dryer)

Safety of Treatment:

Technicians will use Dagnet to spray the home, which is safe for both people, including children, and pets, with the exception of fish. For more information, you can download a Material Safety Data Sheet from our website [here](#)
