



CLOTHES MOTHS

Information & Preparation Sheet

People and pets MUST remain out of the treatment area for the duration of the treatment (1HR) and for 2-3 hours afterwards to allow the product time to dry properly.

PEST INFORMATION & TREATMENT GOALS

Clothing moths typically enter homes through infested clothing or textiles, as well as through open windows or doors. Adult clothing moths or their larvae may hitch a ride into homes on infested clothing, wool rugs, upholstered furniture, or other textile items. These items may already be infested with eggs or larvae when purchased or acquired from second-hand sources. To eliminate them, it is important to kill all larvae on clothing and furniture as well as all adult moths.

TREATMENT AREAS (*INTERIOR ONLY*)

- Along all baseboards in rooms, you've seen moths.
- Inside all bedrooms
- Inside all closets
- Along any carpeted flooring or rugs
- Any additional problem areas discussed with the technician.

TREATMENT PREPARATION

- Clean out all closets – everything needs to come out.
- Wash and dry all clothing on high heat and place into bags or air-tight bins until after the treatment.
- Have dresser drawers open and empty.
- Vacuum all carpets and baseboard areas.
- Cover all fish tanks with a towel/blanket (ensure it is one that has gone through the dryer)

TREATMENT WARRANTY

We include a 6-month warranty with our treatment, which includes up to 3 follow-ups (if necessary) completed at your request.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have asthma; is it safe?

Once the Dragnet is dry, there is no health risk for you to enter the space; however, prior to drying, the Dragnet may irritate your asthma. If you have asthma, we recommend adding an additional hour to your wait time before re-entering the treated area.

2. Will it stain?

The only material Dragnet is known to stain is silk. However, we dilute the Dragnet with water, so if your walls/floors are dirty, they may appear stained because the areas sprayed will be cleaner than the areas untreated. It is also important to keep in mind that Dragnet dries transparent, but until it is dry, it is noticeable.

3. Is it safe for my pets and or my kids?

When dry, Dragnet does not pose a threat to people or pets, with the exception of fish. This pesticide is highly toxic to aquatic creatures, and as such, we will not treat areas around fish tanks, streams, rivers, or ponds.

4. What if it isn't dry when I come home?

There are various reasons that may cause the pesticide to dry a little slower. For example, if it is a cold day or if you have hardwood floors. If the areas treated are still damp, leave for another hour and then return. If there is pooling, the liquid can be cleaned up with a towel and washed. This is common with hardwood floors because they do not absorb as much water, but this is not a concern because the pesticide will have been absorbed, and the liquid remaining will be 95-100% water.
