



PAVEMENT ANT

Information & Preparation Sheet

People and pets MUST remain out of the treatment area for the duration of the treatment (1HR) and for 2-3 hours afterwards to allow the product time to dry properly.

PEST INFORMATION & TREATMENT GOALS

Pavement ants are typically very small (1-3 mm), and their colonies can exceed 10,000 workers. They tend to build their colony beneath the ground in areas we cannot access, such as below your house or driveway. Due to our inability to access the colony, the treatment goal is not to destroy the colony but to keep the ants off your property. We do this by applying pesticides to areas the ants would use to surface from the ground to seek food. When ants sense the pesticide, they will relocate to another area, ultimately keeping them from surfacing on your property.

TREATMENT AREAS

INTERIOR TREATMENT AREAS

- Along baseboards of the ground level (and basement if applicable)
- Inside any cracks where ants can surface
- Beneath sinks / around pipes or fittings on the first level of the home
- Along with any additional problem areas discussed with the technician.

EXTERIOR TREATMENT AREAS

- Perimeter of the house where the foundation meets the ground.
- Along any pavement, such as walkways & driveways
- Along with any additional problem areas discussed with the technician.

TREATMENT PREPARATION

- Pick up any clothes or toys that are on the floor.
- Cover all fish tanks with a thick blanket or a towel.
- Ensure technicians have access to baseboards on the main level of the home.
- Ensure the grass is mowed, especially around the edges of driveways and walkways.
- Remove weeds growing in/around the pavement where you are seeing ants.

TREATMENT WARRANTY

We include a 6-month warranty with our treatment, which covers up to 3 follow-ups (if necessary).

Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have asthma; is it safe?

Once the Dragnet is dry, there is no health risk for you to enter the space; however, prior to drying, the Dragnet may irritate your asthma. If you have asthma, we recommend adding an additional hour to your wait time before re-entering the treated area.

2. Will it stain?

The only material Dragnet is known to stain is silk. However, we dilute the Dragnet with water, so if your walls/floors are dirty, they may appear stained because the areas sprayed will be cleaner than the areas untreated. It is also important to keep in mind that Dragnet dries transparent, but until it is dry, it is noticeable.

3. Is it safe for my pets and or my kids?

When dry, Dragnet does not pose a threat to people or pets, with the exception of fish. This pesticide is highly toxic to aquatic creatures, and as such, we will not treat areas around fish tanks, streams, rivers, or ponds.

4. What if it isn't dry when I come home?

There are various reasons that may cause the pesticide to dry a little slower. For example, if it is a cold day or if you have hardwood floors. If the areas treated are still damp, leave for another hour and then return. If there is pooling, the liquid can be cleaned up with a towel and washed. This is common with hardwood floors because they do not absorb as much water, but this is not a concern because the pesticide will have been absorbed, and the liquid remaining will be 95-100% water.
