



SILVERFISH & FIREBRAT

Information & Preparation Sheet

People and pets MUST remain out of the treatment area for the duration of the treatment (1HR) and for 2-3 hours afterwards to allow the product time to dry properly.

PEST INFORMATION & TREATMENT GOALS

Silverfish & firebrats are attracted to damp, humid environments, so if your home has a moisture problem, such as a leaky pipe or poor ventilation, it can make your home more suitable for them. The treatment is typically very straightforward and usually only requires 1-2 visits to kill the existing silverfish & firebrats. However, we can't prevent them from returning. Getting rid of silverfish or firebrats permanently requires you to address the underlying moisture issue.

TREATMENT AREAS (*INTERIOR ONLY*)

The areas being treated will differ from one house to the next depending on each situation, but common areas to treat include Beneath sinks, around toilets and tubs, around light fixtures, baseboards and window frames, and around any holes/openings in the wall where silverfish may be present.

TREATMENT PREPARATION

- Pick up any small items around the baseboards.
- Remove all items from beneath bathroom & kitchen sinks.
- Thoroughly clean the bathroom, ensuring there is nothing on the countertop.
- Cover all fish tanks with a towel

TREATMENT WARRANTY

We include 1 follow-up within the initial 30 days of treatment, to be completed if necessary and at your request.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have asthma; is it safe?

Once the Dragnet is dry, there is no health risk for you to enter the space; however, prior to drying, the Dragnet may irritate your asthma. If you have asthma, we recommend adding an additional hour to your wait time before re-entering the treated area.

2. Will it stain?

The only material Dragnet is known to stain is silk. However, we dilute the Dragnet with water, so if your walls/floors are dirty, they may appear stained because the areas sprayed will be cleaner than the areas untreated. It is also important to keep in mind that Dragnet dries transparent, but until it is dry, it is noticeable.

3. Is it safe for my pets and or my kids?

When dry, Dragnet does not pose a threat to people or pets, with the exception of fish. This pesticide is highly toxic to aquatic creatures, and as such, we will not treat areas around fish tanks, streams, rivers, or ponds.

4. What if it isn't dry when I come home?

There are various reasons that may cause the pesticide to dry a little slower. For example, if it is a cold day or if you have hardwood floors. If the areas treated are still damp, leave for another hour and then return. If there is pooling, the liquid can be cleaned up with a towel and washed. This is common with hardwood floors because they do not absorb as much water, but this is not a concern because the pesticide will have been absorbed, and the liquid remaining will be 95-100% water.
